
Recent Wins:

- Worked with the NBA on their historic decision to move the All-Star game from North Carolina in the wake of HB2, the legislation Attorney General Loretta Lynch called "state-sanctioned discrimination against some of the most vulnerable members of our society."
- Worked with the NCAA to pull all of their championships from North Carolina.
- Partnered with the NCAA to develop and administer an antidiscrimination survey to guide their choice of locations for key sporting events.
- Created a landmark campaign, Principle 6, which successfully lobbied the International Olympic Committee to include sexual orientation in the Olympic Charter.
- Led athlete participation in campaign to persuade Vice President Mike Pence to moderate Indiana's anti-LGBT "Religious Freedom Restoration Act" in 2015.
- Led the successful #WomenInFIFA campaign, engaging more than 150 Olympic and professional athletes in calling on FIFA reforms to include greater representation of women and increased support for women's football.























The Action Awards celebrates the pioneering actions by individuals and organizations in 2017 that helped create LGBT inclusive athletic environments and eliminate anti- LGBT prejudice.

The annual event features athlete and celebrity honorees and participants, a luxury auction, and the opportunity to network with individual and corporate philanthropic leaders from the sports and business communities.
